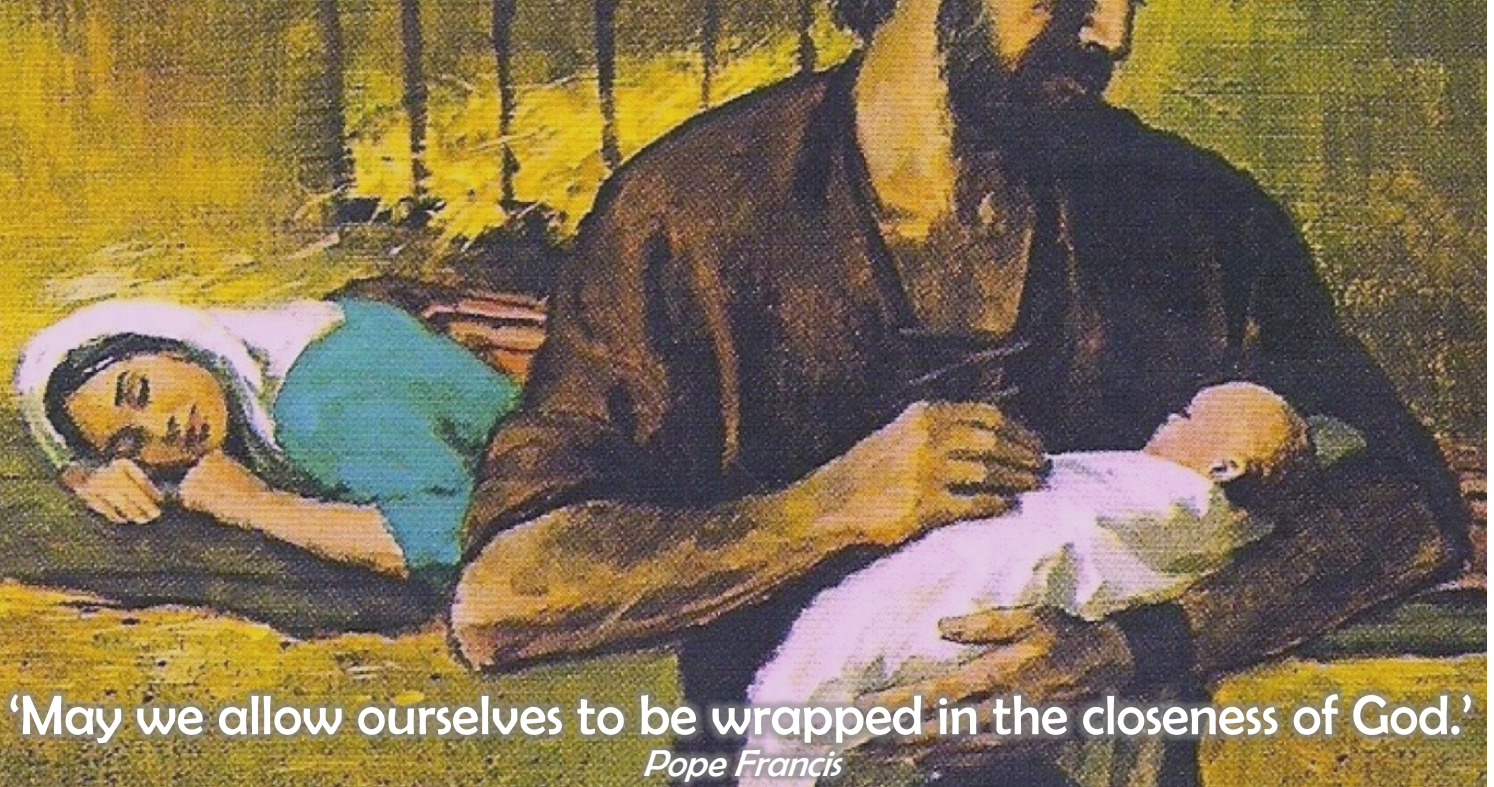
**A Gift: 2026 OBLATE CALENDARS**
