All items will need to be handed into the New Life Centre by lunchtime on Wednesday at the latest for inclusion in Sunday's Newsletter

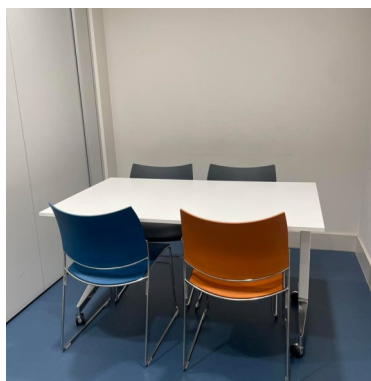
DON'T FORGET the envelopes for the ALTAR LIST OF THE DEAD are available in the Church and the New Life Centre over the month of November.
