SPHERE 17 NEWS



Sphere 17 wish to inform you that the main Sphere 17 RYS, Regional Youth Facility in Darndale will need to close in late 2026 or early 2027 due to

confirmed pyrite damage. The Youth Facility will require extensive repairs, which will be managed by the Dublin City Council Properties Section.

Sphere 17 want to reassure everyone that the building is completely safe and will remain open and fully operational while we work on securing alternative accommodation. We're actively exploring solutions, including modular units or temporary facilities nearby.

While the building will close, youth service will continue. Sphere 17 RYS commitment to young people in the community remains strong, and we will ensure the core services are maintained throughout this transition until we are successfully back home.

If you have any questions, need more information or are aware of suitable local accommodation options, please don't hesitate to contact Sphere 17.

We appreciate your understanding and support. As soon as we have more details on timelines and plans, we will share updates with you.

In the meantime, you are always welcome, Sphere 17 remains **a place to be YOUNg**.
